

## 2025-2026 PROCEDURES TO REQUEST PROFESSIONAL JUDGEMENT DUE TO SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

When your financial aid was determined for the 2025-2026 award year, it was based on the information you provided on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for calendar year 2023. Unfortunately, families sometimes experience extenuating circumstances that affect their household financial situation. Some of these circumstances have a direct effect on the family's ability to pay towards the student's education. The Financial Aid Office will re-evaluate your financial aid eligibility only after receiving all requested and required documentation. Financial Aid may use professional judgment, as long as it is within the intent of the law. Your request will be given careful consideration and will extend the processing time. Financial Aid is NOT required to adjust awards. Making a request for a review of special circumstances does not guarantee an increase in funding.

## All Professional Judgment submissions require the following:

## Dependent Students - Student and Parents/Stepparent

**Independent Students – Student and Spouse** (if applicable)

- 2024 or 2025 Tax Return (signed & dated)
- 2024 or 2025 ALL W2s
- Detailed statement explaining your circumstances and request
