

# APPLICANT CHECKLIST

## APPLICATION DEADLINE: April 22, 2025

Preference will be given to on-time applications. Late applications following the acceptance date will be reviewed for <u>alternate status only</u>. Late applications will be accepted until *August 7, 2025*.

## Apply for admission to Spokane Falls Community College (SFCC).

Contact Admissions at 509-533-3500 or sfcc.spokane.edu.

- If you are enrolled at Spokane Community College (SCC), you still must apply to SFCC.
- If you have previously been enrolled at SFCC, you must reactivate your application.

#### Documents that will need to be uploaded to the PTA online application:

- **Cover letter:** The letter should be addressed to the Admissions Committee and should discuss what makes you an outstanding applicant for the PTA Program
- Demographic Information: Previously applied, Military experience
- Work/Volunteer Experience Form
  - Work/volunteer experience is not required. If you do have work/volunteer experience, a form signed by your supervisor is required to receive credit.
- Coursework Summary It will be helpful to have copies of transcripts to refer to when you fill this section out.
- Applicants will be asked to write about their personal journey as well as the characteristics they embody that will contribute positively to the PTA Program and the delivery of healthcare.
- **Recommendation:** Provide the email of a person who can recommend your entrance to the program. The recommender will receive an email link with a short series of questions. (0 pts)
- Unofficial copy of all of your transcripts (including SFCC and SCC) A Degree Audit is not acceptable. (If you don't already have a copy, most schools have the information available online).
- In addition to the online application, request an *official transcript* from each college you have attended (with the exception of SFCC and SCC). Have the transcript(s) sent directly to:

# Applications should be submitted by Monday, April 22, 2025. Applications submitted after April 22 and before August 7 will be considered alternates and placed on a waitlist.

**INTERVIEW:** The top applicants will be invited for a mandatory interview in May.

\* Regardless of total points, negative feedback from a supervisor who signed the WORK/ VOLUNTEER EXPERIENCE FORM or negative feedback from the recommender may result in denial for acceptance into the program.
