- □ Documents that will need to be uploaded to the PTA online application:
 - Cover letter: The letter should be addressed to the Admissions Committee and should discuss what makes you an outstanding applicant for the PTA Program (0 pts)
 - Demographic Information: Previously applied (1 pt), Military experience (3 pts)
 - Work/Volunteer Experience Form (Total possible points 5)
 - Complete a separate form for each experience (photocopy as necessary).
 - Each form must be signed by your supervisor.
 - Coursework Summary (Total points possible including previous degree: 31) It will be helpful to have copies of transcripts to refer to when you fill this section out.
 - **Recommendation:** Provide the email of a person who can recommend your entrance to the program. The recommender will receive an email link with a short series of questions.
 - Unofficial copy of all of your transcripts (including SFCC and SCC). A Degree Audit is not acceptable. (If you don't already have a copy, most schools have the information available online).
 - In addition to the online application, request an *official transcript* from each college you have attended (*with the exception of SFCC and SCC*). Have the transcript(s) sent directly to:

Applications should be submitted by Friday, April 15, 2024. Applications submitted after April 15th and before August 28th will be considered alternates and placed on a waitlist.

INTERVIEW: This will also include a written essay on site (10 pts). The top applicants will be invited for a mandatory interview in May (10 pts).

*Regardless of total points – the interview score or negative feedback from the supervisor who signed the WORK/VOLUNTEER EXPERIENCE FORM may result in denial for acceptance into the program.
