General Infraction	Citation for parking: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ In an unauthorized area ➤ In faculty/administrative parking without a valid permit ➤ In a safety/visitor zone ➤ Without a valid permit ➤ Improperly (i.e., not in a designated space) ➤ Against flow of traffic ➤ Other – as described on citation 	\$30.00
Research Fee	Unregistered vehicle research fee. Fee is in addition to original infraction fine; assessed if CCS must contact the Department of Licensing for vehicle owner information.	\$20.00
Disabled Parking	Parking without a valid disabled parking permit	\$250.00
Traffic Fine	Moving Violation (Tier One)	\$40.00
Traffic Fine	Moving Violation with Disregard for Safety (Tier Two)	\$80.00
Traffic Fine	Moving Violation, Willful & Wanton Disregard for Safety (Tier Three)	\$80.00
Traffic Fine	Fraudulent Permit	\$160.00

Notes:

1. All campus parking is paid parking, either by meters or paid virtual permits.
2. A virtual permit is obtained by registering your vehicle license plate in the CCS parking management system ccs.nupark.com/portal and paying an appropriate fee to be authorized to park at a CCS facility.
3. Daily, monthly, quarterly, or annual (available for purchase only July 1st – December 31st) virtual permits can be purchased online at ccs.nupark.com/portal. Virtual day parking permits may be purchased at kiosks in several CCS parking lots.
