## HEERF III Funding under the ARP

Reporting Period April 1, 2021 to June 30, 2021

SFCC will be reporting each funding source provided under the CARES Act, CRRSAA Act, and ARP separately and posted online for individuals and students to see.

The following information must appear in a format and location that is easily accessible to the public. This information must also be updated no later than 10 days after the end of each calendar quarter (September 30, and December 31, March 31, June 30) thereafter, unless the Secretary specifies an alternative method of reporting:

(1) An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

On April 10, 2020, SFCC signed and agreed to the terms of the CARES Act Certification and Agreement and assurances to use no less than 50% of the funds received to provide emergency financial aid grants to SFCC students.

As SFCC had previously received HEERF funding under the CARES Act the Certification and Agreement signed originally on April 10, 2020 serves as the agreement for the HEERF III funding under the ARP.

(2) The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.

SFCC received its allocation of HEERF III funding under the ARP on May 25, 2021 for \$6,015,172.00

(3) The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs as of the date of submission (i.e., as of the initial report and every calendar quarter thereafter).

As of 6/30/21, **no students** have been disbursed HEERF III Funding under the ARP as SFCC is still determining the methodology of awarding funds equitably to eligible students. SFCC will award HEERF III funds by the 90-day deadline from receiving funding on May 25, 2021 to ensure SFCC is meeting compliance with the award.

(4) The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.

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As of 6/30/21, SFCC has not determined eligible students as the methodology for awarding funds has not been established.

(5) The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.

As of 6/30/21, no SFCC students have received HEERF III Funding under the ARP.

(6) The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.

As of 6/30/21 SFCC has not determined its awarding methodology for HEERF III funding under the ARP. SFCC will ensure the methodology is created in an equitable fashion and award HEERF III funds by the 90-day deadline from receiving funding on May 25, 2021 to ensure SFCC is meeting compliance with the award.

(7) Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants.

As of 6/30/21 SFCC has not determined its awarding methodology for HEERF III funding under the ARP. SFCC will ensure the methodology is created in an equitable fashion and award HEERF III funds by the 90-day deadline from receiving funding on May 25, 2021 to ensure SFCC is meeting compliance with the award. Once methodology for awarding is established SFCC will reach out to eligible enrolled students on how to apply for emergency assistance.
