## Important information for Winter 2021

The snowstorms we've had already are a keen reminder that it is time to register for Winter quarter!

Our current schedules (for PACE and SEER classes) can be found online at <u>scc.spokane.edu/PACE</u>. To reduce both paper use and the cost of mailing, we'll be using our website for all schedules and forms from now on. If you aren't able to access the website, please call for a paper version.

With Winter Quarter, our processes have changed a bit. Please read this list carefully to ensure speedy and accurate registration. Students:

- 1) need an active email account. Each student must be able to send and receive information.
- 2) **must fill out the SCC Online Application** <u>one time</u>. If students are enrolled in a Fall quarter class, they will do this in one of their classes.

  - c. Students will choose ABE/Transitional Studies as their course of study.
- 3) will choose their classes from the schedule on <u>scc.spokane.edu/PACE</u>.
- 4) will complete these forms:

Our teachers are doing a remarkable job managing both environments simultaneously. Because eating is not allowed in the Lodge due to safety restrictions, please plan your schedule so that you eat lunch at home.

If you don't have a computer to use for online classes, please let us know. We have a few laptops we can loan to eligible students for the quarter.

Students who would like help completing forms, setting up their Bigfoot email, navigating Canvas, downloading Microsoft Office or any other computer assistance can drop in to Help Day - 12/8 and 12/9

**from 9:00 – noon in our computer lab**. Students are encouraged to bring their own devices (laptops, tablets) but if that isn't possible, they can use the computers here. Another change is that **students will have a planning meeting** with a staff member at least once a year; at this meeting they'll sign an acknowledgement form regarding student rights, code of conduct, etc. The goal of this meeting is to ensure that students are making use of all that PACE has to offer in a way that will meet their personal goals, whether those are life or career goals. Employment and transition students will combine this meeting with their other planning meetings.

PACE is now offering a **PACE Certificate**; at the planning meeting students will identify which classes they need in order to earn this certificate. It will be a great way for students to document what they've learned and celebrate what they've accomplished in their time with PACE.
