Second Quarter

ENGL& 102- English Composition II 5cr (COMMUNICATION)

BIOL& 223 – Majors Organismal Physiology with Lab 5cr (ELECTIVE)

MATH 71 – Essentials of Algebra 1, 5cr (if needed per math placement)

(Students who test into MATH& 141, will not need lower-level math courses)

Third Quarter

BIOL& 221 – Majors Ecology/Evolution with Lab 5cr (ELECTIVE)

MATH 72 – Essentials of Algebra 2, 5cr (if needed per math placement)

*SOC& 101 – Intro to Sociology 5cr (or other SOCIAL SCIENCE Group A or B)

Fourth Quarter (Summer)

MATH& 141 – Pre-Calculus I 5cr (**QUANTITATIVE/SYMBOLIC REASONING - Q/SR**)

*HLTH 101 - Health and Wellness 3cr (or other: HLTH 174/104/270) (HEALTH)

*PE 188 2cr – (there are many Physical Ed classes you can choose from) (ACTIVITY)

Fifth Quarter

CHEM& 161 – General Chemistry with Lab 5cr (MATH/SCIENCE) (only offered Fall)

MATH& 142 - Pre-Calculus II 5cr (prep for Calc) or MATH& 146 – Intro to Statistics 5cr (MATH/SCIENCE)

CMST 227 - Intercultural Communication 5cr or **CMST 226** - Gender Communication 5cr (HUMANITIES- **DIVERSITY**)

Sixth Quarter

CHEM& 162 – General Chemistry with Lab II 5cr (ELECTIVE) (only offered Winter)

*POLS 125 – Global Issues 5cr (or other SOCIAL SCIENCE Group B/EWU's Global Studies)

MATH& 151 – Calculus I 5cr or 3cr elective (elective) (Calculus is an optional math for EWU BS Biology)

Seventh Quarter

CHEM& 163 – General Chemistry with Lab III 5cr (ELECTIVE) (only offered Spring)

*MUSC& 109 – World Music 5cr (meets EWU Global Studies)

*PHIL 110 - Intro to Ethics 5cr (or other HUMANITIES) (**Look for a Writing Intensive "W" Course section**)

*When non-bolded examples are used, students may choose ANY COURSE from that area of **Associate in Arts - Direct**

Transfer Agreement – (AA-DTA) – WORKSHEET in COMMUNICATION/QSR/HUMANITIES/SOCIAL SCIENCE/MATH SCIENCE/HEALTH PE /ELECTIVES.

5cr are required in “W” Writing Intensive. Always check to make sure the class section you select for a “W”, is listed as a “W”.

5cr are required in “D” Diversity.

POLS 125 meets EWU’s Global Studies requirement and SCC’s Social Science Group B option, as does, SOC& 201, POLS& 203, or HIST 230.

NOTE:

Some universities require Calculus I, other may require Statistics and some require both. Always check with receiving university to determine exact courses.

Math Sequence for Calculus: Math 71, 72, 141, 142, 151 (depending on Math Placement)

Many universities require 300 level Anatomy and Physiology; thus, it is not listed within this degree.
