*GEOL& 101 – Intro to Physical Geology with Lab 5cr (MATH/SCIENCE GROUP B)

*PHIL& 101 – Intro to Philosophy 5cr (look for W section) (HUMANITIES GROUP C or any other HUMANITIES GROUP B or C only)

FRCH& 122 – French II 5cr (if met through High School, choose **CMST& 230**) (ELECTIVE)

Seventh Quarter

*SOC& 201 – Social Problems 5cr (look for W section) (SOCIAL SCIENCE GROUP A/EWU Global Studies)

*ASTR& 100 Survey of Astronomy 5cr (MATH/SCIENCE)

*CMST 103- Effective Listening 3cr or another elective (ELECTIVE)

FRCH& 123 - French III 5cr (if met through High School, choose **CMST 226**) (ELECTIVE)
