WSU has a priority deadline of Jan. 31st; however, the Speech and Hearing Sciences department will admit students into the program until July 31st prior to fall semester start in August.

The program admits for fall semester only. A cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher is required.

- Biology 106 (L) or Biology 102 (L) SCC BIOL& 160 or (BIOL& 221 & 223 -BIOL& 222 Prereq)
- Chemistry 101 (L) or Physics 101 (L) SCC CHEM& 121 or (PHYS 101 & 102- MATH& 141 prereq)
- Psychology 105 SCC PSYC& 100
- Stats/Math 212 SCC MATH& 146 (placement required)
- If matriculating through WSU Pullman, complete or enroll in SHS 205, Introduction to Speech-Language Pathology & Audiology
- Satisfy all UCORE and approved elective requirements prior to transitioning to the WSU Spokane Health Sciences campus in the fifth semester
- SHS advisor approved electives (17 credits required) including any course 200-level or above that supports a good foundation in speech-language pathology or audiology
- At least 24 semester hours with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher
