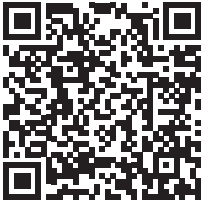

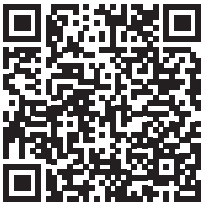

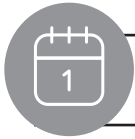

Spokane Falls Community College-Pullman is located on the WSU campus in Pullman, WA. Through an agreement between WSU and SFCC Pullman, SFCC students in Pullman have access to some WSU services. In order to access any available WSU services, students should first get an SFCC ID card from the main SFCC-Pullman office.

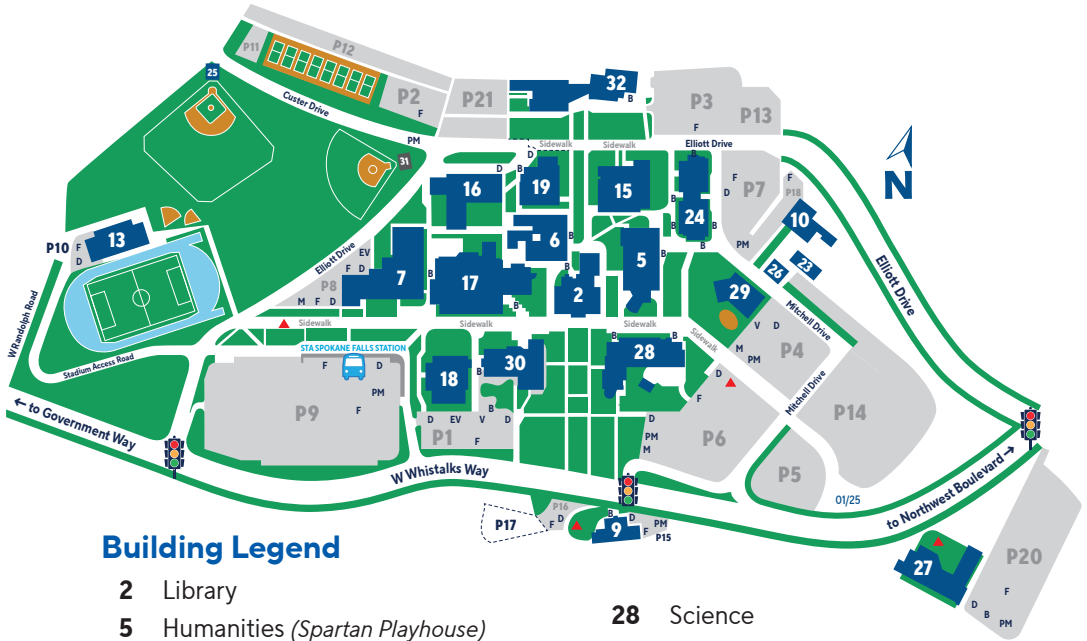
